The following is the completed ballot for the Rio Grande Valley Quilt Shows. After core group meetings and members responses the following information is to be used for the future RGVQG annual shows. Each year's Show Board may add a category to the existing ballot but once that year is completed the ballot for the following year returns to the original core ballot. The Ballot Description Sheet also remains the same. The Ballot and Description Sheet is to be posted in the July newsletter and the October newsletter each year. The October newsletter is to have all the registration information included. This will give quilters advance notice for planning quilt show projects.

Note: January, Miniatures will be voted on by the guild. Winning quilters are to take their ribbons home with them after the guild meeting and another ribbon will be placed on the winning miniature for the purpose of sale at the quilt show.

Note: February, Challenge quilts will be voted on by the guild. Winning quilters will take their ribbons home with them after the guild meetings. The public will then vote at the quilt show on the challenge. Ballots will be color- coded according to the colors selected by the registration committee.

Rio Grande Valley Quilt Show Core Ballot Description Sheet For Public Voting

The following is a detailed description sheet of the RGVQG Core Ballot. This description sheet is to be used each year with the Core Ballot to assist quilters in selecting categories to register their quilted items. This is for Public Voting.

At the time of registration quilters need to be sure to fill out the quilt description areas of the registration form.

Bed Quilts: Pieced, embroidered, appliquéd, hand and machine, whole cloth, twin size or larger.

Wall Hangings: Pieced, embroidered, appliquéd, whole cloth, hand and machine, any size.

Mixed Media/Art Innovative: Multiple techniques combined and visible. Includes original design, improvisation from patterns, class or instructor, embellishments, thread painting, beading, painting on fabric, photography on fabric, etc.

Garments: Clothing, jackets, Christening gowns, skirts, and only **MATCHING** accessories such as purses, bags, shoes, socks, hats and jewelry made to coordinate with a registered clothing item.

Home and Personal: Juvenile quilts, purses, table runners, placemats, hats, totes, jewelry, dolls, children's items such as toys, crib bumper pads and play mats, towels, fabric bowls, Lap quilts, and sofa throws.

Challenge Items: Challenge items that meet guidelines set by the current challenge committee. Items are to be handed into the Challenge Chairperson at registration and will be picked up at the end of the quilt show.
