Prewashing

- ▲ Stops Fraying during Wash: Pinking Shears, Serge
- ▲ Retayne for prewash (not for vat dyed fabrics like indigo)
- ▲ Colour Catcher dryer sheets

Starch or Sizing

- ▲ Best Press Fabric Stabilizer
- ▲ Sta-Flo Liquid Starch (Purex) (Recipe: Mix equal portions of starch and water.)
- ▲ Fine Mist Reusable Spray Bottles

Seam Allowances

- ▲ Riley Blake Designs' Seams Sew Easy! By Lori Holt
- ▲ fast2sew TOOLS, C&T Publishing
- ▲ Diagonal Seam Tape (Cheryl's favorite)
- ▲ Make your own: Index card or 1/4" graph paper, and sticky notes or painter's tape
- ▲ Fusible Batting Tape (must have 1/8" of fabric)

Scrappy, Asymmetrical Look

- ▲ Tensister's Easy Piecing Fusible Grid (<https://www.tensisters.com/>)

Piecing Small Blocks

- ▲ Straight Stitch Needle Plate; 1.8mm stitch length
- ▲ Slow down and use: Stiletto, Fabric Clips, or Elmer's School Glue
- ▲ Sew then Cut
- ▲ Prewash and Starch fabric; Practice

Paper Piecing

- ▲ Translucent Vellum (<https://www.paperpapers.com/neenah-uv-ultra-ii-translucent-vellum-white-85-x-11-paper-17lb-text-500-pk.html>)
- ▲ Pacon® Newsprint Paper 8.5" x 11" (500 count) Product Number: PAC3401 (Office Supply Store)
- ▲ Muslin or silicon pressing mat (to protect ironing surface)
- ▲ Fabric Clips (to organize) (to hold instead of pinning small pieces)

Appliqué Freezer Paper

- ▲ C Jenkins™ Freezer Paper Sheets (Industrial)
- ▲ Smooth Cutting Board **AND** Hard Ironing Surface
- ▲ Parchment Paper **OR** Silicone Pressing Mat
- ▲ Faultless® Niagara Original Hold (Non-Aerosol)
- ▲ Fine Grit Emery Board
- ▲ Small Stiff Bristle Art Brush
- ▲ Small Bowl
- ▲ Cheri's Cool Tool Iron (www.p3designs.com)
- ▲ *Off-The-Block Appliqué* book by, Pearl P. Pereira (www.p3designs.com)
- ▲ Roxanne Glue-Baste-It **OR** Elmer's School Glue

Appliqué Scoring

- ▲ Bone Folder Tool; Hera Tool
- ▲ Soft Ironing Surface

Appliqué Machine

- ▲ Appliqué Foot (open toe)
- ▲ Duckbill Scissors
- ▲ Stitch Sample Swatch, Consider:
(Blanket Stitch, Fine Zigzag, Satin Stitch Zigzag, Blind Hem, and Decorative Stitches you like)
- ▲ Fine Point Marker for Swatch

Autograph Quilts

- ▲ Freezer Paper
- ▲ Tape off writing area (frame)
- ▲ Fabric Pens (write then iron)

Sewing Machine Love

- ▲ Pipe Cleaner, and Bendable Straw
- ▲ **Unwaxed** Dental Floss

Needles & Threads

- ▲ Superior, Masterpiece Granite
- ▲ Empty 5 Bobbins, Change your needle
- ▲ 16 hours of use
- ▲ Hump Jumper use: Change machine's needle, sew over thick seams, sew buttons on thick fabric

Pressing Flatter Seams

- ▲ Ironing Stick (The Strip Block)
- ▲ RNK Turning Tool
- ▲ Tailor's Clapper
- ▲ Quilt Clapper (Quilt-N-A-Flash product)

Miscellaneous

- ▲ 3D Butterflies: Heat/Bond Ultrahold
- ▲ Escort-II Automatic Needle Threader
- ▲ Ultra-Fine Needle Threader (appliqué and beading)
- ▲ Magnetic Knife Board (Kitchen Item)
- ▲ Thin (Remnant) Bar of Soap (dark fabric marker)
- ▲ Removing Blood Drops (spit on your quilt; hydrogen peroxide and Q-tip)
- ▲ **Quilt Labels include:** Quilt Name; Your Name (Maiden-Married); City/State; Month/Year completed; Designer and Quilter
