Featherweight Maintenance – Diana Wolf

Supply List

If you're up North, don't forget to bring your Featherweight back with you!

- ___ Featherweight sewing machine, with foot control.
- ___ A sewing foot that attaches to the presser foot bar (It's likely already on your machine.)
- ___ A bobbin for your machine, empty or not.
- ___ Thread snips or small scissors, optional.
- ___ A couple of scraps of fabric, about 6" in some direction (for testing your machine).
- ___ Brand-new needle - Schmetz brand preferred. Old Singer needles will damage your machine.
- ___ Spool of thread, regular thread you would use for piecing.
- ___ Small bright flashlight or small bright table light, for seeing inside your machine.
- ___ Flat head screwdriver – test to see if it fits in the screws you can see on your needle plate – the metal thingy that surrounds the feed dogs. Not too narrow from side to side, not so fat that it won't go in the slot in the screw. Shorter length will be easier to work with but longer doesn't matter too much. DO NOT remove any screws before class.
- ___ An old soft brush, smallish, to poke around inside your machine. An old natural bristle eye makeup brush is perfect. Many watercolor or acrylic paint brushes work very well.
- ___ A stiffer small brush to clean the gears, an old typewriter brush is perfect.
- ___ Old, used towel
- ___ Wear old clothes! You may get oil or grease on yourself - not likely but possible.

Diana will supply the stuff to dissolve old sewing machine oil, and furnish new oil, along with the applicators for both. She will furnish motor lube as well.
