

RGVQG Schoolhouse Class – October 15<sup>th</sup>  
Miniature Quilts – Vicki Guerra

Supply List

1. Sewing machine – clean, oiled and with a new, sharp needle. Use a neutral color thread on the top and in the bobbin. Put on a ¼" foot.
2. Small cutting mat – 12" x 18" works well. Rotary cutter with a new blade – a sharp blade is a time saver.
3. Rulers: 2 ½" x 6 ½"  
2 ½" x 12 ½"  
6 ½" Square  
Any other ruler you prefer working with. If you are using yardage, bring a longer one. Also, bring any specialty ruler you might have for half-square triangles.  
Example: Bloc-loc, slotted trimmer, etc.
4. Piece of foam core, 15" x 20", covered with batting or flannel, to use as a design board. A piece of foam core from a dollar store, cut in half and covered, will do. Just duct tape the batting or flannel to the back.
5. Mechanical pencil
6. Fabric – This project works well with scraps. You can do your piece in the 1 ½" block size, or the 2" block size, if the smaller one makes you a bit nervous.

Bring enough fabrics for your desired block size -

Cut 16 squares of lights and 12 squares of darks in the size you choose.

We will also be making half-square triangles using the Magic 8 method - bring at least (more is better) 6 light and 6 dark squares, 5" x 5"

In addition, bring fabric for borders.
