Beginning Paper-piecing – Sandy Bagot

### Supply List

- Sewing machine, in good working order, with open toe foot
- Scissors – fabric and paper
- Dark thread
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Small personal iron or wooden iron (you may also use the classroom irons)
- If you have one, or can borrow one, bring the Add a Quarter ruler
- Piece of cardboard – bookmark, postcard, greeting card, etc. will be fine.

For flower in pot - Scraps of fabric in background, flower color, greens for leaves and stem, whatever colors are desired for pot, pot rim and saucer. You could go with terra cotta; a blue and white china look or any other flowerpot colors you want. The largest pieces will be for the flowerpot – approx. 7" x 5" for the pot, and narrower strips for the rim and saucer. Background may be any color you choose.

For landscape - Scraps of fabric in landscape colors – sky, water, assorted greens, golds and tans (for amber waves of grain), tiny flowers and pastels for Spring - whatever you'd like to work with. These should be six strips, from 3.5" x 8" down to 1.5" x 5". The barn and silo require just small scraps. Inner and outer border strips can be your choice of color and size.
