

RGVQG Schoolhouse Class – June 18, 2026
Patchwork Basket – Dale Shafer

Supply List

Fabric color #1, for patchwork - two strips of fabric, cut 2" x 15"

Fabric color #2, for patchwork - two strips of fabric, cut 2" x 15"

Fabric color #3, for lining – just grab a fat quarter, or bring a piece approx. 12" x 12"

One strip, for handles, cut 2" x 10 ½", from either patchwork fabric or lining fabric

One strip, for handles, cut 2" x 10 ½", from base fabric

Base fabric – ¼ yard cotton duck (Michael's had seven colors available, when I recently checked.) ¼ yard is more than necessary, so you might want to share with a friend, or plan on making a couple of baskets. Price is inexpensive - \$1.50 for ¼ yard.

Don't launder this fabric.

Note: The original pattern called for linen; but I didn't want to ask everyone to pay a premium price for this class. If you happen to have a piece of linen on hand, and would like to use it, please feel free to do so.

Interfacing – I'm not up on the many interfacings available today. I used fusible fleece in my samples. If you have a favorite that would give soft body, not stiffness, please use whatever you prefer. You'll need a 12" x 12" piece (approx.).

Sewing machine, in good working order; basic sewing supplies; both pins and fabric clips; ruler; rotary cutter; ironing surface and iron (if you have – there are a couple of ironing boards available).
