

Maple Leaf Table Runner

Supply List & Pre-Class Preparation

Finished size – 16 ½ in x 48 ½ in

Supplies Needed:

Yardage is based on 42" wide fabric

- 3/4-yard background fabric
- 1/2-yard fabric for leaves
- 1 1/2 yards fabric for seamless backing or ¾ yard for pieced backing+
- 1/3-yard binding (optional)+
- 20" x 52" piece of batting+

+ These items are needed to complete the table runner but probably won't be used in class.

Tools needed for class

Sewing machine clean and in good working condition – extra needles	Thread & pre-wound bobbins to match your fabric	Your preferred foot for sewing 1/4" seams
Open-Toe foot for paper piecing	3 ½" or larger square ruler	Optional – Easy Angle 2 ruler, Slotted Trimmer, Point Trimmer
Rotary cutter	Pins/Clips	Seam ripper
Cutting mat	Small trash bag	Scissors
Ruler	Paper and pencil	Fabric marking pencil
Iron	Ironing mat	At least 12 Ziplock bags

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Pre-Class Preparation

All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance. Please bring scraps leftover from cutting to class. Just in case I left something out.

Label the Ziplock bags, 1 for each method (11 methods) and 1 for the table runner.

From background fabric cut:

- 1 – 1 ½" strip
- 1 – 2 ½" strip
- 1 – 6 ½" strip
- 1 – 6 3/8" strip
- 1 – 4" strip

Sub cut each of the strips as shown in the **background fabric layout**. DO NOT cut any of the diagonals (we will cut diagonals in class).

Put the pieces (squares & rectangles) in Ziplock bags per the **Maple Leaf Table Runner Piece Info**.

From the leaf fabric cut:

- 1 – 1" strip
- 1 – 2" strip
- 1 – 2 ½" strip
- 1 – 2 7/8" strip
- 1 – 6 ½" strip

Sub cut each of the strips as shown in the **leaf fabric layout**. DO NOT cut any of the diagonals (we will cut diagonals in class).

Put the pieces (squares & rectangles) in Ziplock bags per the **Maple Leaf Table Runner Piece Info**.

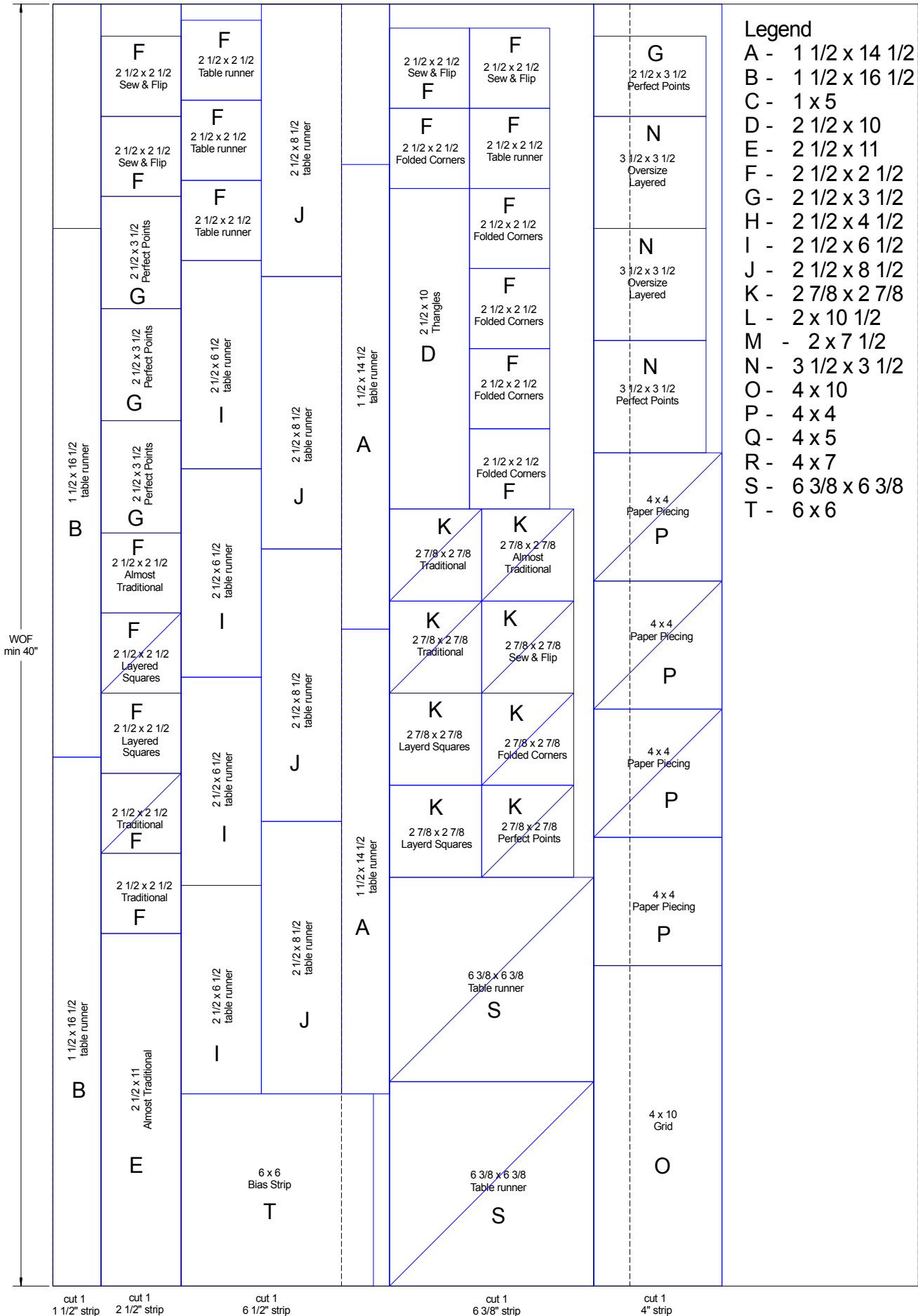

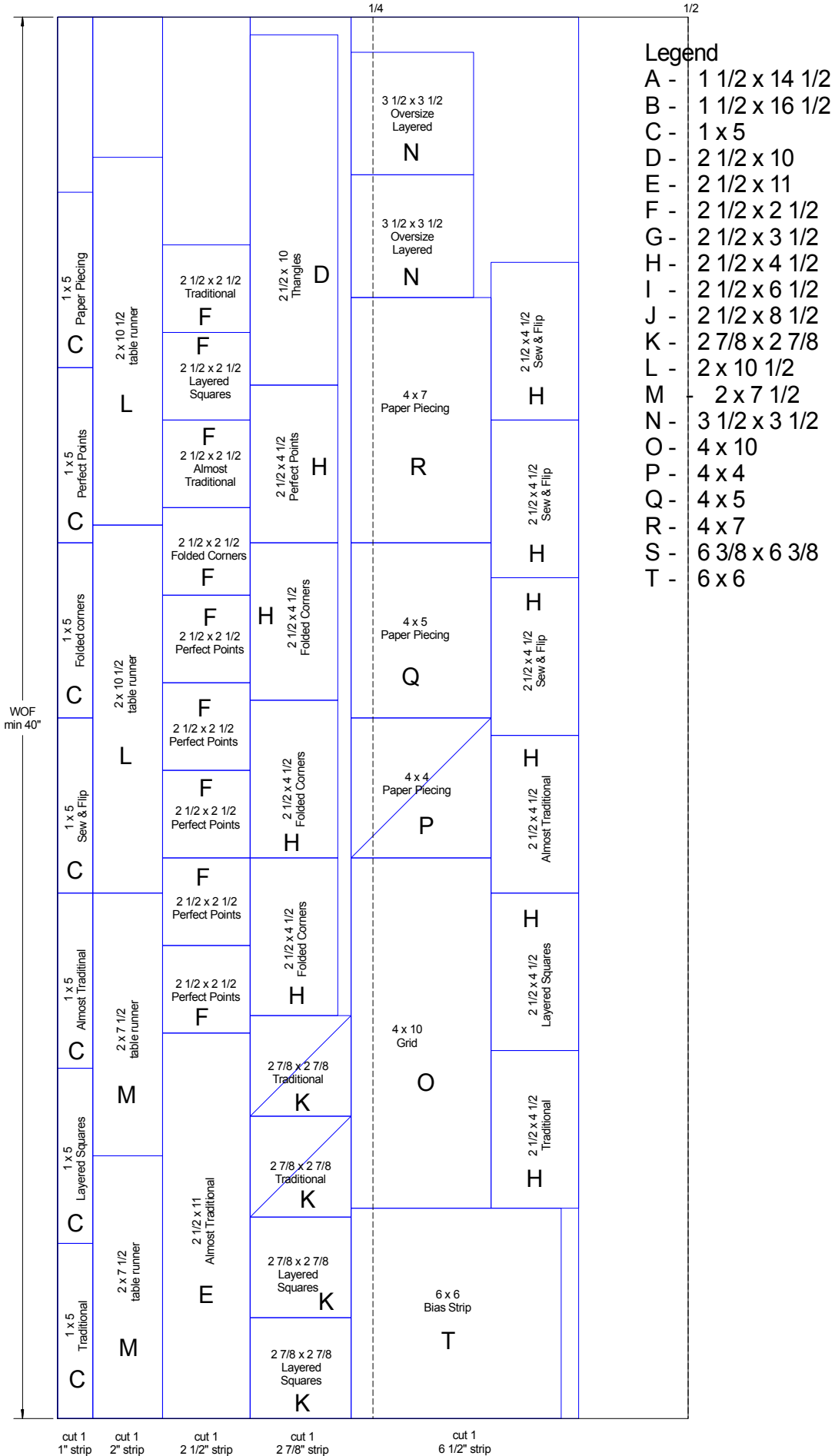
