

MEGA BOW TUCKS BAG

SUGGESTION: If you can cut your pieces, fuse the foam/fleece to the appropriate pieces and quilt the appropriate pieces, we can most likely finish the bag at class.

A couple thoughts before we start with bag requirements:

This bag has so many possibilities which makes it fun to make. First, I am going to give you the fabric requirements as stated on the pattern. I will also give you the dimensions of each piece so that if you have scraps (stash) that you would use to make the bag. Also included with the dimensions will be the amount of fabric needed if you want to buy some.

FROM PATTERN

FABRIC:

(additional yardage may be needed for directional fabrics)

¾ yard for outer bag band, and front pocket lining

1 ½ yards for lower bag portion, handle, tabs and outer pocket

¾ yard contrasting lining fabric

¾ yard for the inner pockets and inside bottom cover

Software:

¾ yard of Bosal 495S **Single Sided fusible** In-R-Foam

20" x 18" (1 ½ yd) Bosal 337 Craf-Tex stabilizer for bottom of bag

1 ½ yd Bosal 326LF (bolt) 426LF (precut) Single Sided Light Fusible Fleece

HARDWARE

This information was sent previously

Below are the dimensions of each piece if you want to use stash/part stash

TOP BAND – 1/3 yd (2 pieces each 5" x 27") or Piano Keys - I used nine (9) different fabrics – cut 4 of each color giving you 36 pieces total each measuring 5" x 2".

FRONT/BACK – 1 yard; 2 pieces each 17" x 27"

BAG LINING – 1 ¼ yards if both inside pieces are the same fabric OR 2/3 yard each of 2 different fabrics; 2 pieces each 20 ½" x 27"

INSIDE POCKET – 1 yard if both pockets are made from the same fabric OR ½ yard each of 2 different fabrics; 2 pieces each 16" x 28"

FRONT OUTSIDE POCKET – ½ yard – 1 piece 11" x 11"

FRONT OUTSIDE POCKET LINING – (also makes trim)/contrast – ½ yard – 1 piece 11" x 12 ½"

HANDLE – 1/3 yard – 2 pieces each 4" x 31"

SIDE SWIVEL HOOK TABS – 1 piece 4" x 20"

HANDLE TABS – 2 ½" x 12"

BOTTOM OF BAG COVER – 12" x 22" (may be pieced using scraps)

SOFTWARE:

I used single sided fusible foam from JoAnns – 2 ¼ yards (20" wide) – I think I gave you the measurement of 1 ¾ yard when I put the hardware list together. I recalculated and came up with 2 ¼ yds. Specific pieces specified in pattern – the bag pieces have 2 pieces of foam since the foam is only 20" wide and the cut is 21 ½".

FUSIBLE FLEECE – 1 yard (46" wide) – specific pieces specified in pattern.
