
Fabric Selection for Rose Star:

In each rose star, there are five fabrics: the center hexagon, the second hexagon, the flower petal that is part of the star, the flower petal behind the star, and the points of the star. With value selection, you can focus on different parts of the design and even create some illusions of transparency.

Fabric Selection

These quilts lend themselves to being scrappy. The value (how light, medium, or dark each fabric is relative to the others around it) makes such a difference in the final look of each Rose Star block. Here are the parts of the block.

Rose Star block

By selecting a variety of fabrics with a wide range of values we can play with the options during the class and get a variety of rose stars. For the background select something that is distinct from the rose star fabrics.

To make one star, cut 1 strip of each of the five fabrics and background 2 ½" wide.

Sub cut strips 2 ½" x 4 3/8"

For A Center Hexagon cut 3 rectangles (2 ½" x 4 3/8")

For B ring around center: cut 6 rectangles (2 ½" x 4 3/8")


For C base of Star points: cut 6 rectangles (2 ½" x 4 3/8")

For D star points: cut 3 rectangles (2 ½" x 4 3/8")

For E flower petals behind star (2 ½" x 4 3/8")

Background 12 rectangles (2 ½" x 4 3/8")

Cut these before class to make one Rose Star Block. (18" x 20")



Fabrics for Table runner 3 Star Blocks finished size 20" x 54"

5-15 fat quarters for the blocks and ¾ yard for background.

Fabrics for lap quilt 7 – 8 Star Blocks finished size 50" x 54"

10 – 20 fat quarters for the blocks and 1 ¾ yd. or 2 ¼ yd. for background.

Fabric for queen 25 stars finished size 80" x 90"

25-35 fat quarters for the blocks and 3 ½ yd. or 5 ½ yards for background

Sewing machine with basic supplies, rotary cutter, ruler and mat
