June will notify you when the pictures have been taken and she will arrange to have the pictures submitted to the quilt gallery link. You can schedule a time to pick up the quilts at that point.

June will have a sign in/sign out sheet for you to sign when you drop off and pick up your quilt to be photographed. Mike Hall will have a Show Quilt Photo Transport Receipt form if he is picking up your quilt/exhibit item.

- 1. SLEEVES: All entries must have an attached 4" sleeve** Attach the hanging sleeve at the top of each item, and this can be done with safety pins no more than 6 inches apart. Quilting Paraphernalia Exhibit items do not require a sleeve.
- 2. LABELS: All entries must have cloth labels on both the entry and the pillowcase (cloth bag).** You will need two cloth labels at least 3" x 3" (larger is ok) with the entry number, your name and your phone number printed in bold permanent marker (e.g. Sharpie). The entry number will be in the email you received when you submitted your registration. Quilting

Paraphernalia Exhibit items do require a label included with the item.

The first label should be pinned with safety pins on the quilt back.

The second label should be safety pinned near open end of the cloth bag or pillowcase.

If your entry is a vintage sewing item, put the item in an appropriate size container and label it with your entry number and contact information.
