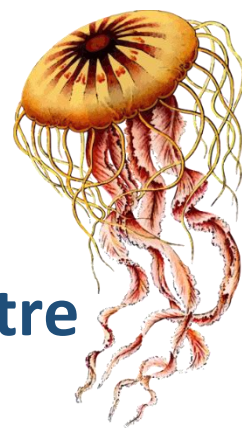

“Storms at Sea”

Any variation of a Storm at Sea.

Any size, as long as it doesn't exceed
the maximum perimeter.

Storm at Sea makes for an exciting quilt –
full of movement – all do to the
juxtaposition of square and rectangle
blocks. Your eyes try to tell you there's
curved piecing, but there's not a curved
seam in the quilt, not anywhere!



Challenge

In celebration of our theme, make a quilt
which features your idea of

“Treasures of the Sea”.

Your quilt should:

- Be an original work. No kits, panels, or purchased applique.
- Have a dimensional technique such as fabric folding, smocking, trapunto, or piping.
- Have at least one creature – flora or fauna from under the sea.
- Have at least one recycled item as embellishment.
- Your completed project can be any shape, but the perimeter can be no more than 240 inches.
