Clip Cushion Supply List

Bring the supplies to make several cushions, as you should have time to make more than one.

Cotton fabrics are your choice - coordinating or scraps. I list them as scraps.

Pre-Class Preparation checklist for each cushion:

- 5 - 2 X 4" scraps for tags
- 4 - 1 X 5" scrap pieces for in between strips
- 2 - 2 X 5" pieces of fabric for the start and finish strips
- 1 - 5 X 5" fabric square for back (leftover charm square would work)
- 1 - 4 3/4" X 11" piece of fabric for inner sandbag (I use muslin, but any cotton fabric will do, since it won't be seen.)
- 1 - 12" X 12" piece of lightweight fusible interfacing, such as Pellon Fusible Featherweight, Style #911FF. **DO NOT SKIP THIS** – it's important. Any brand can be used.

Tools checklist:

- Sewing machine in good working order, with a new sharp needle.
- Thread to match your fabric
- Pins & fabric scissors
- Needle & thread for hand sewing
- BISK (Basic Individual Sewing Kit – this means any sewing notions that you like to work with)
- Point turner & pinking shears if you have them
