

Supply List for Sashiko, Kantha, Kwanza, Boro, Big Stitch

You will be learning different stitches and making samples of each.

\$15.00 kit fee, Includes supplies for Sashiko to include Needles, Fabric, Thread. Batting for Kwanza.

This class is all handwork, no machines.

Bring reading glasses, portable light if needed. Strong reading glasses if needed (+3.0) can be purchased at Dollar Store.

General sewing notions, small scissors, straight pins, thimble. (Nice to have, rubber tip fingers, like they use to sort mail) Rotary cutter/Ruler

Marking pen- chalk/white, needs to show up on blue fabric.

I will discourage using any batiks as they are very hard to stitch through.

3- 14" Squares of fabric (muslin, Kona Cotton works well) preferably white or cream

2- 14" squares print fabric

Scraps in colors pleasing to you, probably 20 to 30 no smaller than 3" x 3". Bring a novelty fabric for fun!

#8 Pearl Cotton Thread, I suggest several colors. Don't over buy, maybe swap colors with a friend.
