

TERMS AND CONDITIONS-RGVQG QUILT SHOW

TERMS AND CONDITIONS - 2020 RGVQG Quilt Show

This agreement is between the Rio Grande Valley Quilt Guild (GUILD) and the undersigned quilt show vendor.

ELIGIBILITY- TERMS AND CONDITIONS-

The GUILD has the sole right to determine the eligibility or termination of any business or product for inclusion in the quilt show.

GUIDANCE - The GUILD seeks to attract vendors that display a quality, retail storefront. Product pricing is expected to follow current market pricing for retail quilt stores. Vendors are allowed one show special and these items should comprise no more than 25% of booth space.

Deviations must be discussed with and approved by the Vendor Chairperson (Marilyn Hensz) prior to arrival and setup.

BOOTH ASSIGNMENTS - The GUILD will assign booth spaces and may make changes in the location of spaces at their discretion; however, preferences of vendors, in regard to location and/or adjacency to competitors will be taken into consideration.

All displays must be within the confines of the booth space. End booths may not use the exterior of the booth for display.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY - Vendor's property are understood to remain under vendor's custody and control, in transit to or from or within the confines of the exhibit hall, subject to the rules and regulations of the exhibition. Under no circumstances shall the GUILD be responsible for any lost merchandise or damage to the merchandise or any other property of vendor.

Vendor agrees to take no claim for any reason whatsoever against the GUILD, volunteers, agents, representatives or service contractors for loss, theft, damage or destruction of goods; nor for any damage of any nature, including damage to his or her business by reason of failure to provide space for his or her exhibit; nor for any action of any nature by the GUILD; nor failure to hold the exhibition as scheduled.

Vendors are encouraged to secure their booth and any valuable exhibit materials each night. Vendor understands and acknowledges that the GUILD does not maintain insurance covering damage, destruction or loss of vendor's property. Accordingly, it is the sole responsibility of the vendor to obtain fire, theft, liability, business destruction, property damage and/or other insurance covering such and other losses.

It is expressly understood that neither the GUILD nor its volunteers, agents, representative nor service contractors shall be liable for damage or injury to the vendor, vendor's guests, invitees, employees or agents person, business or property as a result of robbery, fire, theft, accident or any other damage whatsoever.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS-RGVQG QUILT SHOW

INSTALLING, EXHIBITING, DISMANTLING - Dates and hours for installing, exhibiting, and dismantling will be those specified by the GUILD, in keeping with the requirements of the exhibition hall. Vendor will be liable for handling and storage charges resulting from failure to remove materials from the show floor by the specified deadline. There will be no take-down, including packing/boxing of materials prior to the close of the show on the last day. In this case 4:00 pm Saturday, February 15, 2020.

STORAGE OF PACKING CRATES AND BOXES - Vendors are required to store all packing crates, boxes and booth supplies within the confines of their assigned space, and these materials must be off the display floor and out of sight during the quilt show. If storage of large crates or containers is required, the Vendor Chairperson should be contacted.

SAFETY AND OPERATIONAL RESTRICTIONS - Vendor assumes responsibility for compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal safety ordinances, regulations and codes concerning: fire, electrical appliances, flammable materials, general health and safety, and the environment.

In addition:

- Smoking is not permitted in the exhibit hall.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in exhibitor booths.
- Signs involving the use of neon or similar gasses are prohibited.
- Storage batteries (wet cell) are not permitted inside the exhibit hall.
- Stereos, amplifiers and other sound-generating equipment must be operated at levels that will not interfere with other vendors or cause excessive noise in the exhibit hall. The GUILD reserves the right to final determination as to whether an exhibitor is in violation of this policy.
- All sales activities and booth demonstrations must be confined to the limits of the vendor's booth area.
- Food and beverages are prohibited, except as provided by the concessions booth.
- Sales tax laws as established by the Texas Comptroller's office are the sole responsibility of the vendors.

CARE OF PREMISES - Vendor is liable for any damage caused to the exhibit building, floors, walls, columns, standard booth equipment (table, chairs, draping) and other vendor's property. Application of labels, tape, paint, lacquer, adhesives or other coating to the exhibit building, floors, walls, columns, standard booth equipment is strictly prohibited. Exhibitor agrees to promptly pay for any and all damage to the exhibit building or its equipment, incurred through carelessness or otherwise caused by the vendor or his/her employees, agents, contractors or representatives. Do not use pins or other items that will damage the drapery.

RELEASE - The undersigned vendor releases and forever discharges the GUILD, its volunteers, agents and chairpersons from any and all actions, suits, claims and liabilities (including attorney's fees) which may arise out of or relate to the occupancy and use of any exhibit space or services provided to the vendor under this agreement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS-RGVQG QUILT SHOW

ENTIRE AGREEMENT - These items constitute the entire agreement between the vendor and the GUILD, and such agreement may not be modified, except in writing. If any provision is invalid or unenforceable under applicable law, it is to that extent deemed omitted and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
