Fun Faces! (raw-edge applique) - Joy Paugh

Supply List

The idea behind Fun Faces is to incorporate your interests and personality quirks into a small face quilt - and have a fun time doing it!

Fabric Requirements:

Background:

Your finished face will be about 18x21 inches; however, the background needs to be 3" larger, all around, or approximately 21 x 24". This can be one piece or a combination of several pieces. The background fabrics can be tonal or patterned, but they should be one(s) that will act as a supporting background for your face. Please bring batting and backing, too, already cut to size.

Face:

Your face fabric can be any color – but consider it against the background fabric. The background fabric should not show through the face fabric. If you really like a particular face fabric, but the background shows through, we can cut out the fabric just on the back of the face.

Scraps

Scraps or other fabric to complete your face. Think what fabric would look good for the hair. Are there interests that are displayed in fabric print? Earrings? Eyes? Eyelashes? We will incorporate some of the stitches on your machine for the completion of your face. Everyone will want to share their scraps.

Templates: Once you sign up, templates for the Face, Mouth, Nose and Eyes will be emailed to you. You may prefer to cut everything free hand – either method works.

Sewing machine with Walking Foot:

If we have time, we will stitch our faces to the background. Bring light grey or white thread.

Misc. Sewing Notions:

Regular and small sharp scissors  
Rotary cutter for trimming  
Washable School Glue in a stick
