

## Needle Keeper Supply List

Since wool is not available in the valley, Jean is providing you the option of buying a project kit from her at class, for a fee of \$20. Jean is requesting either exact change or a personal check. She has no way of processing a credit card.

If you are purchasing a kit, it will include the wool, pearl cotton and appropriate needles.

Additional supplies needed to complete this project:

- One fat quarter for the inside of the needle keeper
- Black DMC Pearl Cotton, #8, which will come in a ball. This is for finishing the outside edges of the needle keeper
- Small sharp scissors for cutting wool and trimming threads
- A couple of straight pins
- Thimble if you wish to use one

If you are using your own wool, please keep in mind that wool is different from felt. This project requires wool.

- 5" x 8" Black wool for center of needle holder
- 4" x 3" Light Green for leaf
- 2" x 3" Dark Green for leaf
- 1/2" x 2" Tan for stem
- 2 1/2" x 2" Maroon for flower
- 1 1/2" x 1" Blue for flower center
- 1 1/2" x 1" Gold / Yellow for flower stamen
- 1/2" Black button for closure
- Several colors of Pearl Cotton for Brazilian Embroidery Stitches
- Regular sewing thread to match appliqué colors
- Needles:
  - #22 & #24 Chenille needles
  - #1 Straw / Milliner's needle for bullions

IN ADDITION, you will also need to bring the fat quarter, Black Pearl Cotton, sharp scissors, straight pins, and thimble (if using one) that are listed above for those purchasing the kit.
