

The meeting was called to order at 9:08 am by Carla Mewhinney, President.

Secretary Report: There being no additions or changes to the May 2016 General Meeting Minutes, they were adopted as read.

Treasurer's Report: Karon Jacobson reports that there is \$37,686.62 in the checking account. She presented two scholarships last week, one at Sharyland High School and one in Edinburg. Please, if you have a check from the guild that you have not cashed, do so before the end of the month as she has to do a six month audit.

Programs: Today's speaker is Laura Nunn doing a demo on the Ruffle Bag. All future programs are listed on the web site to include the classes being taught. Sign up sheets are available today or you may do so through the web site.

Schoolhouse: Classes begin in November and are listed on the web site.

Hostess: There are 48 members present with 6 guests (one who became a member today).

Newsletter: News is due the 15th of the month.

Great news! We have three hotels that are hosting us with super rates. La Quinta, La Copa, and The Inn at South Padre. All three have rates of less than \$70 per night (not including taxes) with breakfast included. Just say you're with the RGV Quilt Show. We've contracted for a

limited number of rooms at each hotel, but have the option of increasing that number if necessary. We've already doubled the number of rooms at La Quinta. So if you call and are told there are no more rooms available in the block we've reserved, give me a call and I will arrange to have more rooms opened up. Telephone numbers are listed on the RGVQG.com webpage under Quilt Show.

The Quilted Gallery is not happening this year. But we are allowing sales of hanging quilts, etc. If you have a quilt or quilted item you want to sell, complete the show registration form. Once you have received your exhibit number, complete the Display Quilt Sales Registration form. Both forms are on our webpage.

Are you having trouble deciding what theme for your Challenge Quilt? I have a few more suggestions. How about:

Rocky Racoon And Your Bird Can Sing Can't Buy Me Love Cry For a Shadow I've Just Seen a Face Matchbox Norwegian Wood

I'm working on the design of a pin for the show. I think you'll like it as it goes with our theme.

A Volunteer Chair has been found! Karen Hazlett has stepped up to this vital position. Now we will need volunteers. Without additional volunteers the show will not be successful and if it's not successful then the guild doesn't make any money, as the show is our major source of income. Without that income, we can't afford the quality of instructors we have in our programs; no money for scholarships; or renting the buildings we use for meetings and classes. Yes, we have a plump checkbook at the moment, but half of that money came from this year's show. So, you see how important the volunteers' jobs are.

Karen will have volunteer sign-up sheets beginning in July. All positions are 3 hours and volunteers will get reduced entry tickets.

Admission tickets are now available. They are \$10 per day; \$15 for both days; and \$5 per day for kids. Volunteer tickets are \$5 per day, but may not be purchased in advance.
