

## RGV Quilt Guild - General Meeting, July 9, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Carla Mewhinney, President at 9:03 am.

**Secretary Report:** There being no additions, corrections or deletions the report was adopted as posted in the newsletter.

**Treasurer's Report:** Current balance in the Checking account is \$35,058.69. The account at Compass Bank was closed and a new account was opened at Bank of America. The Board members are currently working on the budget for 2016-2017.

**Membership Report:** Bonnie Hall reports we have 300 members, two new in June and two this month.

**Community Service:** In June there was 81 items donated for a total of 254 hours and a value of \$1,841.50.

**Military Service:** There are approx. 100 tops that need to be bundled with backing and backing to send to the quilters. With this in mind, Mary Jo Havertape and Bonnie Cassidy will be at the clubhouse in Rio Valley estates on Westgate in Weslaco from 9 am to 1 pm Monday thru Thursday and would like volunteers to come and help sew backing and bundle. Please bring sewing machine to help with backings. We are also asking for donations of money or 3 yds of fabric as the guild is running out of fabric to make tops. Christie Pohler will check on costs of fabric by the bolt

**Programs:** Jan McCoy stated that she needs participants for Sue Nichols machine appliqué class and also for the class in December. For a list of the classes and Instructors please see the web site.

**Sunshine & Shadows:** Pat Brothers had surgery, Jan McCoy will have hand surgery on Monday, Sandy Bagot will have hip surgery on the 15th, Kathy Letoule has broken her ankle, Pat Cooper's mother has had a bad fall, and Renee Darks' husband is having some medical issues.

**Hostess:** 48 members present today with 3 guests, 2 of whom became members.

**Newsletter:** News is due the 15th of the month.

**Quilt Show:** Tickets are available as are show pins. Volunteers will only pay \$5/day for each day they volunteer. When they volunteer they will be given a card entitling them to the discount. The youth who participated in the Sew Days for Quilts and Totes will be eligible to enter the show. (Approx. 20 girls of all ages and their parents, aunts etc. participated. These youth and their mothers will be invited to come to Friendship Day. There are now 3 completed Dolphin Duds, thanks a bunch. Last but not least, Volunteer sign up sheets are available today.
