Quilting Tips, Shortcuts & Techniques – Cassino Richardson

Learn to make 9+ challenging quilt blocks using fast and easy tips and short cuts. These projects will be your samples and will NOT fit together into a quilt so use your scraps. Written instructions for each project will be provided in class.

BRING TO CLASS

- \_\_\_ Sewing machine w/ 1/4" foot
- \_\_\_ Cutting mat larger than 12x12
- \_\_\_ Light & dark marking pens
- \_\_\_ Square ruler 10" or larger with 45 degree line down middle
- \_\_\_ Usual sewing supplies; pins, scissors, ripper, neutral thread, etc.
- \_\_\_ 9 or more clear plastic pages for 3-ring binder (optional)

Pre-Class Cutting Instructions

Label each project and pin together or put into separate baggies or the optional clear plastic binder pages from list above.

1. (2) 3" squares alike  
(1) 3" x 5 1/2" contrasting rectangle
2. (2) contrasting 9" squares
3. (2) 7 1/2" squares of contrasting fabric
4. (1) strip each of 2 contrasting fabrics, cut 2 1/2" x WOF  
(1) strip of light or solid fabric, cut 4 1/2" x WOF
5. From 2 darks & 2 lights, cut:  
(1) dark 2 1/2"x 6" (1) light 4" sq.  
(1) other dark 2 1/2"x 4" (2) other lights into 2 1/2" squares
6. (4) 5" squares of background (such as 4 different reds, 4 different yellows, 4 different neutrals or 4 different blues, etc.)  
(1) 5" sq. of contrasting fabric
7. (2) contrasting 5" squares  
(1) 6 1/2" sq. of another color to go with the other two.
