

RIO GRANDE VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING 12-5-18

The meeting was called to order by Bonnie Hall, 1st VP at 1 pm.

Committee Reports as follows:

Programs – Judy Brown reported that Bonnie would pick up Carly Mul from airport but that she needed someone to take her to dinner Friday night as she does not have a car. Renee Darkis and Judi Swanda will do this. Judy has placed the line-up for next year on bookmarks ,they will be available at Saturday’s meeting. She asked if there would be enough interest in her doing a class utilizing your computer for quilt related information, not only on the guild site but also other sites. The answer was yes and she will do this at the April 2019 meeting. The January meeting on batting will have samples of wool batting for members.

Judy asked for feedback on a survey she would like to hand out at the Saturday meeting. A few changes were suggested and she will go with it.

Refunds for Schoolhouse and Program classes must have a payment voucher filled out and given to Karon Jacobson. Those classes registered on Flip cause can be done online. A discussion was held regarding this and there will be further discussion at a later date to clarify the procedure.

Bee Keeper Elaine Muzichuk did not receive the newsletter and wondered if her article was in it. Diana said it was.

Quilt Show – Debi Warner reports that 54 quilts have been registered and that the last day to register is January 26th, 2019. The Quilt Show Board would like to purchase a computer to allow for ongoing continuity/transfer from one Treasurer to another. Debi made the motion, 2nd by Rick Redd that this be done. Motion passed.

Community Service – Rick Redd reported that during November there was total of 281 items, 1621 hours and a value of \$11,752.25. This puts the guild passed his goal of \$200,000.00 for the year. A “thermometer” indicating the overflow will be put up in the Community Service room at the Quilt Show.

Youth Sew – Subie Redd reports that Florea gave a large amount of fabric that had been donated to the youth sewing to her group. Christmas fabric donated will be made into kits for youth to make stockings – they are to make one to keep and others to give away.

Retreat – Karen Heaney reports that she has had only two cancellations and those spots have been filled.

Newsletter – info due on the 15th.

Karen Jacobson - Balance in account is \$5,077.82 She advised that letters for transition of Officers need to go to the bank and signatures on accounts changed. Diane Tewell will be the new Treasurer.

Military Service Quilts – Renee Darkis reports that 4 quilts were given out at Alamo Country Club. Three quilts and 2 w/c quilts are hanging in the Pharr Library thru December. A sew day is scheduled for January 8th at Greengate and the 16th at Trophy Gardens.
