

RGVQG Board Meeting Minutes – Wednesday, May 8, 2019

President, Kathe LeTulle, opened the meeting at 1:00 p.m.

Secretary – Joy Paugh: The April Board Minutes were posted on the RGVQG Website. With no changes or corrections, the minutes were approved and filed.

Treasurer – Diane Tewell: Bank Balance is \$15,316.49. Savings Account Balance is \$33,136.73.

Military Service Quilts – Pam Manley: 1 quilt was presented at Brookridge in Pharr. The committee has plans to present more military quilts on Memorial Day and or 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Membership – Marty Morrison: Marty led the review and comments on the By-Laws of Rio Grande Valley Quilt Guild. (The 'Guild'). Articles 1, 2, and 3 were reviewed from the committee's work. The committee will continue to bring the By-Laws up to date. The goal is to have the work completed by October.

Publicity – Judi Swanda: Judi has no updates until the new location for our meeting is ready to be publicized.

Retreat – Karyn Heaney: There are openings in the Friendship retreat. The Bluebonnet retreat has a waiting list.

Membership – Marty Morrison: 317 members.

Quilt Show 2020 – Marsha Santow: The Wall Hanging category will be split into 2 size categories. There will be 2 new categories. Modern quilts and Novice (first time a member has entered a quilt). An appraiser will be available to appraise quilts for \$50.00 per quilt. The appraiser will also be on hand to judge/critique a quilt for \$5.00.

Webmaster – Bonnie Hall: The quilt show forms will be available on the website by June. Judy Brown is maintaining the programs page.

Community Service – Rick Redd: April figures are: Items – 630, Hours – 4267, and Value - \$30,935.75. Rick and Subie attended the 5<sup>th</sup> grade quilt show that member Cindy Cooksey held at the Dr. Pablo Perez Elementary School. The class has been invited to show quilts at the 2020 RGVQG Quilt Show. Rick sent a letter to the principal.

Youth Sew – Subie Redd: The summer classes will be held once a month. Currently 3 guild members are assisting. In the fall, 4 guild members will be assisting with the youth sew classes. Subie has plans for the students to make 250 Christmas stockings to provide to Children's Hospital in Edinburg. Other civic organizations fill the stockings for the children who are in the hospital over Christmas.
