

Project Bag Supply List & Pre-class Preparation

Project Bags 2.0

Great for organizing everything you need for each of your projects, these handy zippered bags in four sizes have sturdy quilted bases and vinyl windows for visibility of contents. The pattern includes instructions for two styles of border on the bottom: a pieced border or a single-fabric border.

NOTE: One 18" x 58" package of Soft and Stable can make one bag of each size.					
Fusible interfacing* SUP179	¼ yard	⅓ yard	⅓ yard	⅓ yard	N2
Vinyl* (front window) SUP151	4½" x 10½"	5¼" x 12½"	7½" x 13½"	9" x 16½"	N3
NOTE: One 16" x 54" package of vinyl (SUP151-16x54) makes one bag of each size.					
Handbag zipper* (front window) ZIP24, ZIP30, or ZIPYD	One 12" or longer single-slide zipper	One 14½" or longer single-slide zipper	One 15½" or longer single-slide zipper	One 18" or longer single-slide zipper	N4
NOTE: Two 30" double-slide zippers (ZIP30) will make zippers for all four bags.					
Thread to match fabrics	SoFine #50 polyester thread				N5

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NOTE N1: you can also use Pellon Flex Foam available at Jo-Ann Fabric, Walmart, Amazon

NOTE N2: This is SHAPE-FLEX (PELLON SF101), but any light/medium weight fusible will work.

NOTE N3: This is 16-gauge vinyl, I used 20-gauge clear vinyl from Jo-Ann Fabric

NOTE N4: Regular zippers work fine.

NOTE N5: I'm not picky, most any good thread will work

You will also need sewing machine, manual, needles, thread, pins, seam ripper.... all of your usual sewing tools

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Pre-class Preparation

- 1) Use the cutting layouts on the next page to pre-cut the vinyl, stabilizer and interfacing for 4 bags. We will only be making one of the bags in class, but you'll be ready to make the rest at home.
- 2) Page 3 of the Project Bags 2.0 pattern has the cutting layouts for the fabric. Please choose and cut for at least one of the bags.
- 3) The last two pages of the pattern have tags to help keep track of what pieces you have cut. You'll have to make a copy and cut them out if you want to use them.

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
